

Australian Government JobKeeper Payment within Sage WageEasy

Important Information – JobKeeper Payment

Sage is continuing to work with the Australian Tax Office (ATO) to establish payroll requirements under the new **JobKeeper Payment**.

We are pleased to provide you with instructions for you to pass on to your customers on how to configure Sage WageEasy to cater for this important government initiative.

There are strict rules outlined by the ATO on how these payments are to be tracked. To ensure that these rules are met, customers need to configure allowances in their system to record these payments correctly and report them appropriately via STP.

Failure to comply with the exact naming convention of the Allowances will prevent the ATO identifying JobKeeper data through STP reporting.
